WHO: **Everyone** and Anyone can participate in Takeover. It's most impactful when done in groups

WHAT: Takeover the city, specially by choosing locations to **show acts of kindness and share the love of Christ.**

WHEN: **Anytime.** You can decide to do a takeover anytime, but we want to encourage everyone to **join us for a corporate Takeover on Sunday March 24th** following Sunday Morning service.

WHERE: **Anywhere.** Takeovers can happen anywhere. We encourage you to choose places you'd normally go or you can patronize. Like restaurants, retail stores, gas stations, grocery stores ,etc. **For our upcoming takeover we want to takeover Old Town Pasadena.**

HOW: Takeovers are meant to be done with a group of people, so grab your VSquad, ministry team, a group of friends and follow the steps below:

1. **Decide your takeover.** Where are you going and what are you doing?
2. **Pick a day and time**, our upcoming corporate takeover is Sunday March 24th, but you and your group/team can takeover anytime!
3. **Wear Victory merch.** We encourage you to wear the "God loves Pasadena" shirt but you can wear any Victory shirt. Note: The purpose behind everyone wearing the same shirt is so that it sparks curiosity about who you are, but more importantly why you're doing what you're doing. Victory merch can be purchased on our website.

4. **Go Takeover!**

Here are some helpful tips/guidelines:

- Be respectful of the management and property of where you're doing you're takeover. Depending on what you're doing, it may be wise to ask permission or let someone know what you're doing.
- Be prayerful, ask God to lead you. Ask for wisdom on who you should engage with and how we should engage with them.
- Have fun, enjoy the time of fellowship with your group, team , etc.
