7 DAY GUIDE BASED ON THE PRAYER OFJABEZ



Focus: God Will Showcase His Glory Through the Contradiction

1 Chron. 4:9 – "Jabez was more honorable than his brothers..."

DO THIS:

Write down the contradiction in your story. What's the "pain name" you've been living under?

Ex: Named by "divorce," "failure," "fatherlessness," "debt," "addiction."

REFLECT:

What if the very thing that contradicts your call is what God is using to confirm your purpose?

DECLARATION:

"My pain is not the period. It's the setup for a sentence that ends in glory."

TUES DAY

Focus: Prayer Pulls the DNA Results

"Jabez cried out... and God granted his request." -1 Chron. 4:10

DO THIS:

Write your "legal petition" to God today. Don't beg—petition like you're in the courtroom. Use bold language:

- "Bless me"
- "Enlarge me"
- "Be with me"
- "Protect me"

REFLECT:

Are you praying like someone who has a right to be heard? Or like someone just hoping to be noticed?

DECLARATION:

"I'm not praying for pity—I'm petitioning from position."

WEDN ESDAY

Focus: If He Doesn't Rename You, He Robes You

Isaiah 61:3 - "...a garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness."

DO THIS:

Dress in something today that makes you feel like purpose.

Then stand in front of a mirror and say:

"This is what favor wears. This is what recovery looks like."

REFLECT:

Are you dressing for your past or your promise?

DECLARATION:

"God didn't change my name, but He changed what I wear. I'm clothed in confidence, not shame."

THUR SDAY

Focus: Rename the Label

Genesis 2 – "...whatever the man called each living creature, that was its name."

DO THIS:

Take one area where you've been mislabeled (Ex: "failure," "insecure," "ugly," "too late") and rename it with truth.

Ex: "Failure" → "Faith Trainer"

REFLECT:

Who gave that label permission to live in your life?

DECLARATION:

"I will no longer answer to what life called me—I answer to what God clothes me with."



Focus: Cry Out in Legal Language

Luke 18:7 – "...will not God bring about justice for his chosen ones, who cry out to him day and night?"

DO THIS:

Pray aloud today with courtroom authority. Use Scripture in your language:

- "You said You'd supply all my needs..."
- "You promised to be with me..."
- "You declared no weapon would prosper..."

REFLECT:

Do your prayers sound like hope or legal conviction?

DECLARATION:

"I'm not praying from emotion—I'm pleading my case with evidence!"

SATU RDAY

Focus: Walk in What You Prayed For

Mark 11:24 – "...believe that you have received it, and it will be yours."

DO THIS:

Take one physical action today that reflects what you prayed for:

- Believing for increase? Clean out old space for the new.
- Praying for healing? Dress like you're already well.
- Asking for relationship repair? Send the text.

REFLECT:

Are your actions preparing for what you asked God for?

DECLARATION:

"I won't wait till it shows up—my faith is already moving furniture!"



Focus: Don't Let What Named You Silence What God Gave You

Luke 15:22 - "Quick! Bring the best robe... ring... sandals..."

DO THIS:

Come to worship (in person or online) wearing your royal mindset.

Before you log in or walk in, say:

"The robe is proof. The ring is proof. The sandals are proof. I'm validated."

REFLECT:

Are you showing up in life like an orphan or an heir?

DECLARATION:

"I'm not just attending church—I'm entering like someone whose case has been settled in Heaven."
